This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Mrs.S.Monika, Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.A.Sachignanandakumar, Public Prosecutor for the State / respondent, and upon hearing both side and upon perusing the documents, this court delivers the following;

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to relax the condition imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.1559/2026; Dated: 04.08.2026.**

The petitioner is the Accused in Crime No.196/2026 before respondent police for the alleged offence u/s.304(2) of BNS and he was enlarged on bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.1559/2026; Dated:04.08.2026

with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders.

The learned petitioner Counsel argued that, since the petitioner was granted bail in Cr.No.124/2026 in Kamanaickenpalayam police station, Cr.No.127/2026 in Kamanaickenpalayam police station and Cr.No.126/2026 of Sulthanpettai police station, he was not able to abide the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.1559/2026 dated;04.08.2026 and he cannot abide the conditions imposed in four bail orders at a time and hence, prays to modify the condition so as to enable him to abide the condition before the Judicial Magistrate, Palladam.

The learned Public Prosecutor per contra argued that, the petitioner has neither abide the condition imposed in the instant case nor in any one of the other three cases and so, he has objection in modifying the condition.

Both side heard and records carefully perused. As rightly pointed out by the learned Public Prosecutor, the petitioner has not complied the condition imposed by this Court for a single day and has also not complied the conditions imposed in other three bail orders too. By considering the above said conduct of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to modify the condition as prayed for by the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
