This bail application has been filed before this court through Online and this Petition is coming for final hearing on 11.03.2026 in the presence of Thiru.K.Thirukumaran,MA.,B.L., Advocate for accused and Thiru.S.Balan, B.A.,B.L., Additional Public Prosecutor for the complainant and having stood for consideration to this day, the Court delivered the following:-

Order

This application was filed by the Petitioner/Accused for enlargement of bail u/s.483 of BNSS the Learned counsel for the Petitioner/ Accused argued that this accused was remanded to judicial custody on 25.07.2025 and he was been judicial custody for the past 213 days and prayed for bail.

2. Percontra, The Learned APP filed a reply stating that this accused has 4 previous cases and prayed for dismissal.

3. Heard both sides and records perused. on careful perusal of records the accused was remanded to judicial custody on 25.07.2025 based upon execution of NBW and the main case pending for production of witnesses on the side of prosecution. Hence considering the duration of custody for past 213 days and considering fact that this case is about to be tried and taking note of all such facts this court inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail on following conditions:

1. Accused should executed a bond of Rs.10,000/- along with two surities for the same like sum.
2. Accused should not indulge in any offence.
3. Accused should appear before this court daily at 10.00 a.m., on all working days until further orders.
4. Accused should appear for all the hearings without fail.
5. Accused should not tamper the witness in any manner.
