

13062 2022 State vs. Simranjit Singh, FIR No.168/2022

Present: Ms. Neeraj Azad, APP for the State.
Sh. Davinder Singh, counsel for applicant.

Arguments heard. Police report perused. The police in writing as well as learned APP for the State orally stated that they have no objection, if the vehicle **car Swift bearing no. PB46-S-5455** is released on sapurdari to the applicant namely Gursharan Singh. The applicant is registered owner of the vehicle in question as per the copy of registration certificate produced on record. The presentation of challan/police report and then its disposal is likely to take long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the vehicle-in-question for an indefinite period, more particularly, when there is not much space in the police station to park the vehicles. Hence, the vehicle in question is ordered to be released on sapurdari to the applicant namely Gursharan Singh on sapurdarinama in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court on the undertaking that he will produce the vehicle in question in Court as and when required by the court and will not sell and change the colour and condition of the same till the disposal of the case without prior permission of the Court.

As per the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide judgment dated 19.04.2010 passed in writ petition (c) No.14 of 2008, titled as General Insurance Counsels & others Vs. State of Andhra Pradesh & others, the Station House Officer is further directed to prepare a detailed proper punchnama of the case property to be released on sapurdari and to take photographs of the afore referred case property which are to be duly attested by the Station House Officer, himself.

The Station House Officer has to ensure that the registration number of the case property concerned should be clearly visible and legible in the photographs so take and attested by him, which is displayed on the case property both on its front and rear side.

Requisite Sapurdari bonds not furnished.
