This petition came up for final hearing on this day, before me, with Mrs.M.Sathyavani,M.A.,B.L., Advocate for the petitioner/complainant, after perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court passed the following

ORDER

1. This Petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is the complainant to condone the delay of 28 days in representing the complaint.

2. **The essence of the petition;**

The petitioner, after issuance of the statutory notice to the respondent has filed the case within limitation period. The petition was returned for paying insufficient court fees and also court fee has not paid in the name of the Petitioner. As the petitioner has lost his online court fee receipt, he was not able to represent the case within time. The delay of 28 days in representation of the petition is to be condoned and the complaint is to be taken on file.

3. Now the point for consideration is 'Whether the petition is to be allowed or not'?

4. Petitioner side heard and considered.

5. The petitioner claim that as he has lost his online court fee receipt he was not able to represent the case within time and a delay of 28 days have incurred which is to be condoned. It could be seen that the petitioner has not filed any documents in support of his claim. Nevertheless, considering that it is imperative upon this court to consider the similar petitions in a puposeful manner to meet the ends of justice, and considering that though no supporting documents is filed as stated by the petitioner to hold it as 'sufficient cause', this court is inclined to allow this application.

In fine, the Petition is allowed and the delay of 28 days in representiong complaint is hereby condoned.
