This petition came up for final hearing on this day, before me, with Mr.K.Karthik, Advocate for the petitioner/complainant, after perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court passed the following

ORDER

1. This Petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is the complainant, under section 142 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (in short N.I Act), to condone the delay of 48 days in filing the complaint.

2. **The essence of the petition;**

The petitioner due to oversight and for reasons beyond his control could not file the complaint in time. The delay incurred is neither deliberate nor due to lethargy on the part of the petitioner. The delay of 48 days is to be condoned and the complaint is to be taken on file.

3. The Petitioner side heard and considered.

4. The petitioner claim that due to oversight and reasons beyond his control, he could not file the complaint in time and a delay of 48 have incurred which is to be condoned. It could be seen that the petitioner has not stated any specific reasons which could be considered as plausible. Nevertheless, considering that it is imperative upon this court to consider the similar petitions in a puposeful manner to meet the ends of justice, and considering that though no supporting documents is filed as stated by the petitioner to hold it as 'sufficient cause', this court is inclined to allow this application.

In fine, the Petition is allowed and the delay of 48 days in filing the accompanying complaint is hereby condoned.
