This petition filed on 25.06.2026, came up for hearing before this Court, today, in the presence of the learned counsel for the petitioner Thiru. K. Karthick B.E.,B.L., and the Assistant Public Prosecutor, Thiru.S.Bahavatsingh, B.A.,B.L., Grade – 1, for the state, heard both the counsels, records perused and having stood up for consideration till this day, this court passed the following

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed under section 480 of BNSS ACT.
2. Notice was given to the Assistant Public Prosecutor and the concerned police regarding the petition.
3. As per the petitioner, the petitioner is not involved in the said offences, he did not commit any offence as alleged by the respondent. The petitioner is innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is coming from well reputed family and his not likely to abscond or unaway. He is having permanent

residence and the petitioner is a law-abiding citizen, that if the petitioner is released on bail, he will not abscond or engage in the act of dispelling the witnesses, and if he is released on bail, he is ready to produce surety and that he will appear for the trial subject to the conditions imposed by the court and therefore the petitioner may be released on bail.

4. The respondent raised serious objection that the accused is released on bail, there is a high possibility that he will commit similar offences again, that the accused will abscond and that he will intimidate and disarm witnesses and objection was raised to enlarge the Accused on bail.

5. Both sides heard. Case documents considered. The Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 13.06.2026 and is in Judicial custody since then. The final report in the case has been filed and the same is taken on file a C.C.No.175 of 2025 and trial have begun and the case now stands posted on 09.07.2026 for await L.W.4 to L.W.7 by then. Considering that the nature of offence comited by the accused and the fact that the trial have begun and if the Accused is released on bail, he may abscond, intimidate the witnesses and disperse them and involve in similar offences again, considering the objection raised by the police, this court is inclined to dismiss this application.

In fine, the petition is dismissed.
