ORDER

The petition is filed by the petitioner/appellant/accused u/s.438 of BNSS praying an order to enlarge the petitioner/accused on bail.

2) The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the accused has been charged for the alleged offence u/s.120(B), 395, 353 506(ii) of IPC and the petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 02.12.2025.The petitioner/accused is an innocent person and he has not committed any such offence

and he is having permanent residence and hence he will not abscond or evade process of law. The petitioner/accused ready to undergo any condition to be imposed by this court and the previous bail application in Crl.M.P.No.843/2026 dated 11.02.2026 was dismissed by this court. Hence, prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

(3) The learned respondent police on the other hand objected to grant bail by stating that the case was pending for a long period and the accused residing at other state and the accused will be absconded to drag on the case proceedings. If the accused is released on bail he would not appear before this court for hearing and prayed to dismiss this application.

(4) Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and the investigation has not been completed and the previous bail application of the accused has been dismissed by this Court. As the case remains in the same position without any progress and hence, this court is not inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, this bail petition is dismissed.
