This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Sel.R.Nalini, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and the Learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.S.Sathiamoorthy, on behalf of the complainant and this court passed the following,

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner u/s 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) - 2023, praying for anticipatory bail.

Notice was issued. Reply was filed by the prosecution.

The Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is being charged for the offences u/s 294(b), 323, 324, 355, 506(ii), 326 of IPC in Cr.No.7/2021 of Adirampattinam Police Station and absconding charge sheet has been filed and taken on file in CC No.82/2024 and thereafter, the trial court issued NBW against the petitioner on 26.02.2024 and hence, he prays anticipatory bail for the petitioner.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the contentions put forth on the side of the petitioner and he further submits that this is the case of the year 2021 and NBW is pending before the trial court and hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

Both sides' contentions are taken into consideration. It seems that the case has been taken on file in CC No.82/2024 and pending before the trial court and further, NBW has been issued against the petitioner and it is pending for execution. When a warrant issued by the court is in force, the petitioner has to appear before the concerned court and seek appropriate relief in accordance with law. Hence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

In the result, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
