This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru. S. Dravidan, Learned Advocate appearing for the Petitioner/ Intervenor and Thiru.M.Saravanan, Learned Advocate appearing for the Respondents/accused and the Learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.S.Sathiamoorthy, on behalf of the complainant and this court passed the following,

ORDER

The de-facto complainant's father filed this intervention petition praying to dismiss the anticipatory bail petition moved by A1 to A4 in CrI.M.P.NO.1621/2026.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the intervenor has reiterated the contentions put forth in the intervention petition and his specific objection is that the accused persons assaulted his son Keerthan with sword and caused injuries on his head and hand and he further submits that 34 stitches and 7 stitches were made on his head and hand respectively. He further submits that the police had not properly recorded his complaint statement and the case has to be registered by including for the offence of attempt to murder and one more accused is to be added in this case. He further submits that in this regard, he had given a complaint before the Superintendent of Police, Thanjavur on 04.03.2026 and the copy of the same were sent to CM Cell, State Human Rights Commission, DGP of Police, IG of Police, DIG of Police, DSP of Police, Thanjavur District and to the Inspector of Police, Vallam Police Station and to that effect, he filed the copy of the complaint and the photos showing the injuries of the injured person and hence, he prays to dismiss the anticipatory bail petition moved by A1 to A4.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the accused persons/ A1 to A4 denied the contentions reiterated in the intervention petition and prays to dismiss this intervention petition.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State leaves the matter to the discretion of the court.

By considering the rival submissions put forth on either sides, this court is inclined to allow this intervention petition.

In the result, this Intervention Petition is allowed as prayed for.
