Notice issued to complainant received back duly with the report of incomplete address. No fresh address of complainant is on file. In my opinion, to proceed shall be wastage of precious time of the Court and it shall also put unnecessary burden on the State Exchequer. This increases unnecessary pendency of the cancellation report. Moreover, as per the instructions of the Hon'ble High Court issued vide letter no. 22963.9azII(2), dated 17.08.2017 and considering this fact and circumstances, proceedings are ordered to be closed under Section 281 BNSS, 2023. Further, if the complainant appears anytime before the Court for getting his/her cancellation report disposed of, the same would be made re-open for its disposal in accordance with law. Consequently, cancellation report be consigned to record-room after due compliance.
