This petition came for final hearing before this court in the presence of M.Janani, Advocate for the Petitioner/A2 and Thiru.N.Ranjith, Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, on perusal of available material records as well upon hearing both and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following :

ORDER

1. Petition filed u/s.483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner on bail.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner/A2 would submit that the petitioner has been charged for the offences under section 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act 1985 for the alleged possession of 1.200 kgs of ganja. The petitioner is in custody from 29.05.2026 and he is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

The learned counsel for the petitioner added that the petitioner never committed the said offence and has a permanent address and if bail is granted he will not evade the process of law and prayed for bail.

3. On the other hand the Special Public Prosecutor has objected to release the petitioner on bail and pointed out that the investigation is initial stage. There are 2 accused in this case and the petitioner is A2. Further, no previous case against him and if released he would abscond and prayed for dismissal.
4. Considering the submissions made by the prosecution, though the petitioner is in custody for only 10 days as pointed out by the prosecution if released the chances of he committing similar offences and the investigation is still at the initial stage, the petition seeking bail stands dismissed.
5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
