This petition came up before this Court for hearing moved by Mr..A.G.Saravanan, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and the Learned Public Prosecutor Mr..S.Sathiamoorthy, Public Prosecutor for the State and this court passed the following,

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioners u/s 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) - 2023, praying for anticipatory bail for the offence u/s 303(2) of BNS in Cr.No.93/2026 of Thiruvonam Police Station.

The case of the prosecution is that on 07.04.2026, totally four accused persons including the petitioner herein / A2 committed theft of two goats belonged to the de-facto complainant Devendran.

According to the petitioner, he did not commit the alleged offence and ready to abide by any condition to be imposed by this court and hence, prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The Learned Public Prosecutor had objected to grant bail to the petitioner and he has eleven more previous cases and stated that the investigation is pending and if bail is granted, the petitioner might commit similar offence, tamper evidence and curtail investigation.

Considering nature of offence, and considering many theft cases are pending against the petitioner and considering pendency of investigation and other facts and other circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
