This petition came for final hearing before this court in the presence of L.Priyadharshini, Advocate for the Petitioner/A2 and Thiru.N.Ranjith, Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, on perusal of available material records as well upon hearing both and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following :

ORDER

1. Petition filed u/s.483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner on bail.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner/A2 would submit that the petitioner has been charged for the offences under section 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act 1985 for the alleged possession of 1.200 kgs of ganja. The petitioner is in custody from 01.06.2026 and he is an

innocent person. The learned counsel for the petitioner added that he has been falsely implicated in the matter based on the confession statement of A1. At the time, the alleged offence took place, the petitioner/A2 was at his home and the petitioner never committed the said offence and has a permanent address and if bail is granted he will not evade the process of law and prayed for his release on bail.

3. On the other hand the Special Public Prosecutor has objected to release the petitioner on bail and pointed out that the petitioner has around 9 previous cases and he is a history sheeter H.S.No.535/2022 and co-accused bail petition was dismissed by this court and if released he would abscond and prayed for dismissal.
4. Considering the facts before this court, this petitioner was involved in possession of 1.200 kgs of ganja and he has 9 previous case and he is in custody for the past only 16 days as pointed out by the prosecution if released the chances of he committing similar offences and the investigation is pending, the petition seeking bail stands dismissed.
5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
