This petition came for final hearing before this court in the presence of Tmt.S.Saratha, Advocate for the Petitioner/A1 the concerned station police official for the Respondent/Complainant, on perusal of available material records as well upon hearing both and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following :

ORDER

1. Petition filed u/s.483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner on bail.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner/A1 would submit that the petitioner has been charged for the offences under section 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act 1985. The petitioner is in custody from 02.06.2025 and he is an innocent person for the alleged

possession of 1.250 kgs of ganja. The learned counsel for the petitioner added that he got surgery for his leg injury in the prison hospital and he need further proper treatment and he need care with affection and rest. Otherwise he may suffer with permanent injury in his whole life days and the petitioner never committed the said offence and has a permanent address and if bail is granted he will not evade the process of law and prayed for bail.

3. The respondent has objected to release the petitioner on bail and pointed out that the charge sheet has been filed and taken on file as CC.No.6/2025 and he has six previous cases and if released he would abscond and he would commit the similar offence and prayed for a dismissal.
4. Considering the prayer of the petitioner, this court while extending judicial custody had done through video conferencing only from the Government hospital at Pudukkottai even as on 09.06.2026 and 23.06.2026, as he was undergoing treatment and even was operated upon in his leg. Hence, considering his health condition, this court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail with the following conditions;
 1. that the Petitioner/A1 is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Thanjavur and out of two sureties, one of the surety shall be blood relative of the Petitioner/A1.

2. that the Petitioner/A1 shall report before the Judicial Magistrate No.1, Chidambaram daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.
3. that the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.
4. that the petitioner shall not induce or threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence.
