ORDER

1. This petition for bail filed by the petitioner through Superintendent, District Prison at Pudukkottai and the same was taken on file in Cr.M.P.4137/2026.
2. Notice was given to the respondent. It is stated by the petitioner that he is in custody from 10.11.2025 to till date. Further, there is no one to release him on bail and prayed for bail.
3. On the other hand the Special Public Prosecutor has objected to release the petitioner on bail and pointed out that he has three previous cases and he is a history sheeter in H.S.No.27/2022 and and if released he would abscond and prayed for dismissal.

4. Considering the prayer of the petitioner, the quantity involved is 1.100 kilograms of ganja which is an intermediate quantity and not a commercial quantity. Indeed the petitioner is in custody from 11.11.2025 and the charge sheet not yet filed. Hence, this court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail with the following conditions.

1. that the Petitioner/Accused is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Thanjavur and out of two sureties, one of the surety shall be blood relative of the Petitioner/Accused.
2. that the Petitioner/Accused shall report before the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvudaimaruthur on all working days at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 8 weeks.
3. that the petitioner shall not abscond during investigation and trial.
4. that the petitioner shall not induce or threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence.
