Cheif Examination

Now, I am working as Assistant Professor at Bengal Hospital. When I was working as Assistant Professor at Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur on 24.08.2023 one Kirubanantham aged about 69 years was admitted in Neuro Surgery ward and diagnosing him and found **left high fronto parietal fracture** with hematoma. He was given medicine and discharged from the hospital on 26.08.2023 and I gave a opinion that the injury sustained by the injured is **greivous in nature** and I issued Medico Legal form on discharge. Which is **Ex.P6**.

On the same day, one Appusamy aged about 65 years was admitted in Neuro Surgery ward and diagnosing him and found **right parietal bone fracture**. He was

given medicine and discharged from the hospital on 26.08.2023 and I gave a opinion that the injury sustained by the injured is **grevious in nature** and I issued Medico Legal form on discharge. Which is **Ex.P7**.

Cross Examination by all the accused

Question - whether the injuries sustained by the Kirubanantham and Appusamy would have been caused in motor vehicle accident.

Answer - The above said injuries may also have been happened to them on motor vehicle accident.
