This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal has been preferred by the appellant / husband under Section 28(1) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, challenging the fair and decretal order dated 05.04.2024 passed by the Learned Principal Subordinate Judge, Thanjavur, in HMOP No.29/2022, in which the appellant's divorce petition was

dismissed.

The petition in HMOP No. 29/2022 has been filed by the petitioner / husband under Section 13(1)(ib)(iii), praying to pass a decree of divorce dissolving the marriage solemnized on 06.12.2009 between the petitioner and the respondent at Sri Balaji Wedding Hall, Ayyampettai.
