This Petition filed U/s 480 BNSS by the Petitioner/accused seeking to grant bail to the petitioner/accused for the offence U/s. **316(2),318(4) , 66(D) IT Act** in Thanjavur Cyber Crime Police Station, Cr. No. 01/2026 and this petition coming on this day for hearing before me in presence of Thiru. N.Selvaraj , Advocate for petitioner/accused and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent/complainant this court made the following:

ORDER

Petition for bail.

1. The Learned Counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner was Judicial custody from 19.02.2026 for the past 22 days and he has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner submitted that he has permanent residence and ready to produce the sureties for him. Hence, pray for bail.

2. On behalf of the state the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor filed objections stating that the investigation is not yet over and if the accused is enlarged on bail, he may tamper with the witnesses, and may abscond to other districts. Petitioner/Accused involved in more than no cases. He is regular offence committed in various district. Hence it is strongly objected to grand bail. It is therefore prayed that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to Dismiss the petition and render justice.
3. The respondent/complainant objected that the accused was judicial custody from 19.02.2026. no previous cases are pending this accused. If bail is granted, he will be absconded and tamper the witnesses and involved the same offence in future and investigation is pending. Hence pray for dismissal.
4. The nature of offence involved in this case is **316(2), 318(4) ,66(D) IT Act** Considering the nature and circumstances of the case and that accused are in custody for 22 days and investigation is pending. Hence, this court is not inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
