1. This is an application seeking regular bail filed on behalf of applicant, namely, **Aditya**.

2. Reply has already been filed by SI Rajiv Kumar. Copy has already been supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

3. Arguments have already been heard on 17.10.2022.

4. Present FIR No. 676 of 2022 dated 12.09.2022 was registered on the complaint of the complainant Deepak Kumar alleged that on 11.09.2022 at about 10.30 p.m. when he was going to his house from his workshop and reached near Krishna Vatika, Vijay Vihar, Phase-I, Delhi, three boys robbed his mobile phone make Redmi which was kept in black colour cover which was also containing Aadhaar card of the complainant. When the said robbers were trying to escape from there, complainant shouted and with help of public persons, he succeeded to catch one of the robbers, namely, Aman @ Bunty who was beaten up by the public persons and rest of them fled away from the spot. The

role attributed to the applicant/accused is that during the course of incident, he threatened the complainant with a shaving blade. The alleged shaving blade has been recovered and robbed mobile phone was recovered from the possession of co-accused Amit.

5. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that applicant is in judicial custody since 12.09.2022 ; he has been falsely implicated in this case ; he has no previous involvement : investigation in this case has already been completed and trial is going to take substantial time to commence and conclude.

6. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for State has opposed the bail application of the applicant/accused on the ground that the allegations against the applicant are serious in nature.

7. I have heard the arguments and have gone through the record.

8. Applicant is in judicial custody since 12.09.2022. Recovery of robbed mobile phone of the complainant and the weapon alleged to be used in commission of offence, have already been recovered. Applicant has no previous involvement. Investigation in this case has already been completed. Trial is going to

take substantial time to commence and conclude.

9. Considering the aforesaid, applicant is granted regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. MM/Link MM/Duty MM concerned subject to the conditions that (1) he will not try to threaten or influence the complainant or witnesses ; (2) he will not try to tamper with the evidence ; (3) he will not indulge himself in similar nature of offences ; (4) he will not leave the jurisdiction of Delhi-NCR without permission of the Investigating Officer of the Court as the case may be ; (5) he will appear before the Court regularly to face the trial (6) in case, he changes his address, he will inform the same to the Investigating Officer or the Court as the case may be.

10. Copy of this order be sent to the applicant/accused through the Jail Superintendent ; copy be also given to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused and copy be also sent to IO/SHO concerned for intimation.
