This application has been moved seeking release of the applicant/ accused Hariom on personal bond who was admitted to bail by this court vide order 07.03.2024 subject to furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 15,000/- with one surety in the like amount. However, the applicant/ accused could not secure his release because he failed to furnish requisite bonds due to poor financial condition.

The address of the applicant was sent for verification through concerned IO/SHO.

Reply filed by the IO and the address has been duly verified.

In view of the report filed, this court is of the considered opinion that no one shall prefer to languish in custody despite bail order except he is compelled by the circumstances. ***Accordingly, the present application is hereby allowed. The accused be released on furnishing personal bond of Rs. 15,000/-.***

The application stands disposed off.
