From the pleadings of the parties following issues are hereby made:

- i) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for declaration that the notice bearing no. SDUKNL/2022/59 dated 12.04.2022 & SDUKNL/2022/60 dated 12.04.202 are illegal, null & void and not binding upon the plaintiff being arbitrary and illegal? OPP
- ii) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for permanent injunction restraining the defendants from recovering the alleged amount as mentioned in demand notice and for further restraining the defendant from disconnecting the electricity? OPP
- iii) Whether the plaintiff has not come to the Court with clean hands and has suppressed true and material facts being involved in the offence of theft of electricity?OPD
- iv) Whether the plaintiff is estopped by his own act and conduct?OPD
- v) Whether the present Court has no jurisdiction to try the case as per the provisions of Section 126 and 135 of Indian Electricity Act?OPD
- vi) Whether the present suit is not maintainable? OPD
- vii) Relief

No other issue pressed or claimed. Onus not objected to. Now, to come up on 29.08.2023 for evidence of plaintiff. PF, DM and list of witnesses be

filed within fourteen days, otherwise witnesses shall be brought at own responsibility. Examination-in-chief of the private witnesses shall be in the shape of affidavits. Copies of affidavits of the witnesses be furnished to the opposite counsel well in advance. The parties are at liberty to opt for any ADR mechanism. Admission or denial of the documents be also filed, if any.
