1. This case is charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Swamimalai PS alleging that the accused had committed offence punishable under Section U/S. 4 A, TNP Act.

2. Accused pleaded guilty and Petition u/s. 275 BNSS filed and allowed. Accused voluntarily plead guilty for the offence u/sec.4 A, TNP Act.. of particular are now read over and explained to him in vernacular. I accept the plea of guilty of the accused and hold his guilty for the said offence u/s. 4 A, TNP Act.. Accused admitted the offence and Admission petition also filed and allowed. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He pray for leniency. Lenient view is taken as only fine can be imposed. In the result, the accused is found guilty and convicted for the offence under Section .4 A, TNP Act.. The accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.100/- each and in default of payment of fine, to undergo simple imprisonment for one month Total fine of Rs.100/-.
