JUDGMENT

1). The case of the prosecution is that, on 25.01.2018 at about 7.00 p.m., near Sakkottai Junction Park, all the accused allegedly uttered obscene words against the complainant, assaulted him, and damaged the vehicle bearing Registration No. TN 68 M 2566 (TATA Ace) using a wooden log, causing damage to the tune of Rs.6,205/-. It is further alleged that the accused threatened the complainant by brandishing the wooden log. On the basis of the above allegations, the Sub-Inspector of Police, Nachiyarkoil Police Station, filed a charge sheet against the accused alleging commission of offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 352, 427 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2). This case was taken on file as CC No.270/2025 and summons were issued to the accused. On appearance of A1 to A3, copies were furnished to them under Section 230 of BNSS. Today, the case was posted for framing of charges. Accordingly, charges were framed against the accused, and they admitted the same and voluntarily filed an admission petition. The admission petition in Cr.M.P. No.____/2026 is allowed. Hence, this Court concludes that A1 to A3 are found guilty of the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 352 and 506(ii) of IPC and they are convicted accordingly. The learned counsel appearing for the accused submitted that the accused have no previous conviction and that they have already deposited the damage amount of Rs.6,205/- at the time of passing the bail order. He therefore prayed for leniency and for imposing the minimum punishment. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the submissions made on behalf of the accused and the absence of previous conviction, this Court is inclined to impose the following sentence:-

3) The accused 1 to 4 submitted that, “தவறை ஒப்புக்கொள்கிறோம், குறைந்த பட்ச தண்டனை கொடுங்கள் அய்யா”,

4). In the result, the accused A1 to A3 are found guilty and they hereby convicted for the offences punishable as follows:-

(i) The Accused A1 to A3 are found guilty and convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 100/-(3X100) each for the offence punishable under Section 294 (b) of IPC. In default of payment of fine, each accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for one week.

(ii) The Accused A1 to A3 are found guilty and convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 100/-(3X100) each for the offence punishable under Section 352 of IPC. In default of payment of fine, each accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for one week.

(iii) The Accused A1 to A3 are found guilty and convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/-(3X500) each for the offence punishable under Section 427 of IPC. In default of payment of fine, each accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for one week.

(iv) The Accused A1 to A3 are found guilty and convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/-(3X500) each for the offence punishable under Section 506 (ii) of IPC. In default of payment of fine, each accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for one week.

(v) The total fine amount of Rs.3,600/- and the amount of Rs.6,205/- already deposited by the accused at the time of passing the bail order shall be paid to the victim as compensation under Section 395(1) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. There is no property involved in this case.
