This petitions are coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of
THIRU.A.KANNAN, Advocate for the petitioner in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and
THIRU.P.MARIAPPAN, Advocate for the petitioner in Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 and
THIRU.K.SUBRAMANIAN, the Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon
hearing both sides arguments, this Court passed the following :

COMMON ORDER

**Since both the petitions arose out of one and the same crime number, this
court decides to pronounce common order.**

The petitioners/accused in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 were
arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 12.05.2026 and 15.05.2026 respectively
for the alleged offences under Sections.109(1), 132, 296(b), 351(3) BNS Act,
registered by respondent police, seeks bail.

These two bail petitions are filed by petitioners stating that they have charged for
the alleged offences under sections 109(1), 132, 296(b), 351(3) BNS in
Cr.No.284/2026. The Petitioners further states that, they are innocent and the alleged

occurrence is said to have been taken place on 12.05.2026 at about 08.00 a.m at near North side of Bridge, Kooniyur. As per the averment in the FIR when the police parties searching the accused at the occurrence place, the petitioner is alleged to have use filthy language and prevent the police from discharge the duty and attempt to attack with weapon and threatened with criminal intimidation. The petitioner states that they are innocent and seeks to enlarge them on bail.

The Respondent filed objections stating that, when the police parties were taking up round on 12.05.2026 at about 08.00 a.m. three persons who were standing near Kooniyour bridge have taken weapon kept by them in their back and attempted to cause injury to the police persons by using filthy language. Since the timely action of the police evaded the incident of causing death by the action of the said persons. Further they have caused criminal intimidation and thereafter run away and therefore this police parties preferred the complainant in the police station. Thereafter they were arrested and remanded to judicial custody. Further, the accused Premkumar @ Thangapandi has got two previous cases. Further the complainant and the accused have got per-existing enmity and they are trying to kill each other and criminal conspiracy behind back. Therefore, the respondent police have got serious objections to release the petitioners on bail. Further, two cases are pending as against the petitioner Mr.Ramesh.

The point for consideration is: Whether the petitioners are entitled to the relief of Bail as prayed for?

Point: -Heard both sides. The Petitioners who have been charged for the alleged offence of attempt of murder of police parties and also causing criminal intimidation, when the police party is making rounds in the local area. The petitioners states that they are not actually involved in the offence and claim that they are innocent, whereas the police states that each petitioner have got two previous cases and the complainant and other parties and accused herein are making conspiracy to kill each other and therefore there is a threat of disturbance to the public order and they are objecting to release the petitioners on bail. This court upon consideration of the

allegations as against the petitioners and also finds that the petitioner are in jail, namely the petitioner Ramesh is under judicial custody for the past 26 days and other petition namely Premkumar @ Thangapandi is under judicial custody for the past 29 days. Therefore upon consideration of the detention period of the petitioners, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions.

- i) that the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 is ordered to be enlarged on bail on executing their bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate,Cheranmahadevi;
- ii) that the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or Bank pass book to ensure their identity
- iii) **that the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 shall report and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of one month** and further respondent police is directed to submit the report, deviations if any committed by the petitioner in observing the above condition. On further condition that he shall make available himself for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer ;
- iv) that the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;
- v) that the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 shall not abscond either during investigation or trial ;
- vi) that on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate / Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.2407/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.2410/2026 released on bail by the learned Magistrate / trial Court themselves as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji -vs- State of Kerala (2005) AIR SCW 5560) ;
- vii) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
