This is an application filed by plaintiff Narayan for adjournment contending that his advocates are out of station and hence in absence of them his cross-examination be adjourned and hence it is prayed to adjourn the matter. This application is resisted on behalf of defendants contending that by the consent of both parties and their advocates today's date is fixed for cross-examination of plaintiff. Defendants are ready for cross-examination of plaintiff. So it is prayed that application may be rejected. It is further contended that if application is allowed costs of Rs.500/- be imposed on plaintiffs.

2. Heard both sides. True it is, that today's date is fixed for cross-examination of plaintiff by the consent of the parties and their advocates. Both parties are present. Advocates for plaintiffs are absent. Hence it is not desirable to take cross-examination of plaintiff in absence of their advocates. Hence application is allowed subject to costs of Rs.300/-.
