This petition is filed on 29.05.2026 by the petitioner, pending before this court, in the presence of Advocate Tr.S. Vishnu, B.A., L.L.B., Learned counsel for Petitioner/Accused and learned APP for state and after perusing the records, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1. This bail petition is filed u/s.480 of BNSS by the petitioner who is accused for the offence punishable U/Sec. 78, 79 BNS 67 of IT Act r/w 4 of TNPWH Act.

2. The respondent police filed objection stating that the investigation is pending and the petitioner may tamper the witness and hamper the investigation and further submitted that if the accused is released on bail there is a likelihood of his involvement in similar criminal activities, and strong objection is raised against granting bail to the accused.

3. The Learned APP in his reply stated that the concerned police station has submitted to their reply, as per the version of the police reply in the above said case investigation is pending not yet completed. In the above such circumstances if the accused released on bail he may abscond and tamper the witnesses and commit similar offence in

future. Hence, the Learned APP strongly object to release the accused on bail and prays for dismissal of bail.

4. The petitioner/accused filed petition for seeking bail for alleged offence U/Sec. 78, 79 BNS 67 of IT Act r/w 4 of TNPWH Act and he was arrested and remanded to Judicial custody on 28.05.2026. The petitioner/accused has been in Judicial custody for the past 7 days. The alleged offence against women seems to be grave and sensitive in nature. Investigation also not yet completed. The police had strongly objected for releasing him on bail stating that he may commit similar offence. It is immature time to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused. Considering the respondent side objections, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused and dismiss the petition.

5. Hence, The petition is dismissed.
