Defacto complainant and accused are present. Court HC present and identified the Complainant. Complainant reported that they compromised the matter out of the court and reported the same to this court on 11.02.2025. Mandatory period of 90 days was given. Defacto complainant filed a memo stating that still she wish to proceed with compromising the case. Matter is referred to Lok Adalath. Sd/- I/C.
