Order no. 60 dated 11.06.2026

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail application dated 08.06.2026 filed on behalf of the accused person, namely, Indira Tiwari and written objection, if any, in the meantime.

Ld. Legal Aid Defence Counsel representing accused Indira Tiwari is present.

Ld. Public Prosecutor is present.

Now, the bail petition dated 08.06.2026 is taken up for hearing.

At the very outset, Ld. Counsel for accused submitted that no bail petition is pending/disposed of before/by any upper forum.

Ld. Counsel for accused submitted that she is languishing behind the bar since her arrest on 19.10.2023 and there are 26 witnesses relied upon by the prosecution in this case out of whom only 04 have been examined so far. Ld. Counsel further submitted that several inconsistencies are there in the evidences examined so far which weighs against the prosecution and it does not justify her continued incarceration. He also submitted that she has a fixed place of residence under the jurisdiction of this Court and there is no chance of her absconsion. He prayed for enlarging her on bail in any terms and condition.

On the contrary, Ld. Public Prosecutor raised vehement objection against the bail prayer of accused and submitted that the victim was brutally murdered at her matrimonial house and that the gravity and nature of the offence are such as to disentitle the accused from being released on bail at this stage. She further submitted that the trial of this case is going on in full swing and the other accused persons are absconding and granting her bail at this stage would create a real and imminent risk that she might abscond or interfere/tamper with witnesses or evidence.

Perused the case record as well as the case diary and the materials appearing therein.

The victim, being a young lady, died at her matrimonial place within 05 months of her marriage in an unnatural circumstances. The trial of this case has commenced, however, some of the vital witnesses are yet to be examined.

Considering the seriousness of the allegation and other materials available in the case diary, case record as well in the charge sheet, it does not appear to be a fit case for granting bail.

Accordingly, the bail application dated 08.06.2026 filed on behalf of the accused person, namely, Indira Tiwari stands **rejected**.

To date, i.e., **06.07.2026** for production of accused persons and evidence.
