ORDER

Accused is voluntarily plead guilty for the offence of which particulars are now read over and explained to him in Marathi, I accepted the plea of guilty of accused and hold him guilty for the said offence.

Considered the nature of the offence and antecedents of the accused, I am of the view that the accused does not deserve for the benefit of probation under section 4 of the Probation of Offenders Act.

Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He prayed for leniency. Lenient view is taken as the first offence of the accused. In the result, I pass following order :

ORDER

Accused is convicted for the offence punishable under section 12 (A) of the Bombay Gambling Act, vide section 275 of the BNSS and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment till rising of Court and to pay fine of **Rs.500/- (Five Hundred Rupees only)**, and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for eight days.

The seized muddemal material of warli matka is worthless. Hence Disposed as per rules after the period is over. The amount of Rs. 370/- be credited to state.
