This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.L.Balaji, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

**ORDER**

Petition for Bail.

The petitioner/Accused filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 296(b), 329(3), 326(g), 324(4), 351(2) of BNS in Cr.No.313/2025 of Kilpennathur Police Station.

Heard Both sides. Records perused.

The learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner/accused would contend that the petitioner/accused is an innocent persons and he is no way connected with the above alleged offences, the petitioner is in judicial custody from 26.02.2026 and he is having a permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused setting fire over the cattle shed and thereby causing fire injury to the cattle staying inside the cattle and one more previous case is pending against the petitioner, the investigation has not been completed hence opposed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstance of the case, and the nature of offence said to have been committed by setting fire over the cattleshed and thereby causing fire injury to the cattle staying inside the cattle, which is serious in nature and on considering the serious nature of the offence, and one more previous case to the credit of the petitioner, non completion of investigation, strong objection raised on the side of the prosecution, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail petition is dismissed.
