This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.S.Vishnu, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for bail

The petitioner/Accused has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS Act, praying to grant bail to him for the alleged offences punishable under sections, 123, 275 of BNS and Section 24(1) of COTPA Act **inCr.No.41/2026 of Kalasapakkam Police Station.**

Heard Both sides. Records perused.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/Accused would contend that the petitioner/accused is an innocent person and he has noway connected with the above alleged offences, the petitioner is in judicial custody from 18.02.2026, the petitioner is having a permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused was found in possession of banned tobacco products worth about Rs.35300/-, and also 3 previous cases to the credit of the petitioner, and the investigation has not been completed. Hence he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offences, said to have been committed by the petitioner by selling banned tobacco products, and 3 more previous cases to the credit of the petitioner, non completion of investigation, strong objections raised on the side of prosecution, at this stage, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the Bail Petition is dismissed.
