This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.P.Sriram, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

**ORDER**

Petition for bail

The petitioners/Accused have filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge them on bail for the alleged offences punishable 296(b), 126(2), 351(3), 103(1) of BNS in **Cr.No.500/2025 of Kalambur Police station.**

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners has not committed any offence as alleged and they have been falsely implicated in this case and they are in judicial custody from 20.12.2025, the earlier bail petition was dismissed in Crmp.274/2026 dated 11.1.2026 and they are having permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioners/accused assaulted the deceased and committed murder, the investigation has not been completed.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the offence, period of incarceration, ( 79 days), **co-accused has already been released on bail by the order**

of the Hon'ble High Court, completion of material portion of investigation, and in the absence of any strong objection, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

In the result, this Bail Petition is allowed with the following conditions:

(1) The Petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- each (Rupees Ten Thousands Only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

**(2) The Petitioners shall stay at Madurai and report before the Thallakulam police daily at 10.30. am until further orders.**

3) The Petitioners shall not tamper any witness, they should co-operate with the investigation, they should not make any undue influence on the witnesses, they should not indulge in any other offence in future and not to leave the station either to abroad or other State without permission of this Court.
