This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.A.Azaruddin, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

**ORDER**

Petition for bail

The petitioner/Accused has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. **123, 275, 62 of BNS r/w 24(1) of COTPA Act in Cr.No.101/2026 of Arni Taluk Police station.**

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

**The Learned Counsel** appearing for the Petitioner/Accused contended that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in judicial custody from 06.03.2026 he is having permanent residence and also ready to abide by any condition imposed by this court and hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused was found in possession of tobacco products and no previous cases are pending as against the petitioner and the investigation has been completed.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence, period of incarceration, ( **10 days**), **and the fact of first time offender of this case,**

completion of material portion of investigation, and in the absence of any strong objection, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail Petition is allowed with the following conditions:

(1) The Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousands Only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

3) The Petitioner is directed to report before the learned **Judicial Magistrate Polur daily(except court holidays)** at 10.00 A.M. for a period of 15 days from the date of his release without fail.

4) The Petitioner shall not tamper any witness, he should co-operate with the investigation, he should not make any undue influence on the witnesses, he should not indulge in any other offence in future and not to leave the station either to abroad or other State without permission of this Court.
