K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for Bail.

The petitioner/A2 has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS, prays to grant bail to him for the alleged offences punishable under sections 25(1)(a), 25(1B) (a) of Arms Act 1959 and 35 of TN Forest Act 1882 in Cr.No.41/2026 of AdhamangalamPudur Police Station.

Heard Both sides. Records perused.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would contend that the petitioner has not committed in any offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case the petitioner is in judicial custody from 06.03.2026 the investigation is almost over, the petitioner is ready to abide any condition imposed by this court, the petitioner is hereby undertake that he will not abscond and will not tamper any witness and hence prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused and co-accused person by possessing the country made gun and also using for hunting wild animal in the reserve forest and the investigation is pending and hence, opposed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstance of the case and the nature of the offence said to have been committed by the petitioner by possession the country made gun without licence from the competent authority and also using for hunting wild animal in the reserved forest are all serious nature and on considering the serious nature of the offence, non completion of investigation, strong objection raised on the side of the prosecution, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail petition is dismissed.
