This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.S.L.Babu, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

**ORDER**

Petition for bail

The petitioner/Accused has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 123 BNS r/w 8(C), 20(b) (ii)(A) of NDPS Act in **Cr.No.47/2026 of Tiruvannamalai PEW Police station.**

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner/Accused contended that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in judicial custody from 11.03.2026, the petitioner is having permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused was found in possession of 10 grams cannabis and no previous case is pending as against the petitioner and the investigation has not been completed. Hence opposed to grant bail to him.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, and nature of the offence said to have been committed by the petitioner, non completion of investigation and strong objections raised on the side of prosecution, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the Bail Petition is dismissed.
