This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.L.Balaji, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for Bail.

The petitioner/Accused filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 296(b), 329(3), 326(g), 324(4), 351(2) of BNS in Cr.No.313/2025 of Kilpennathur Police Station.

Heard Both sides. Records perused.

The sister of the petitioner appearing for the Petitioner/accused filed an affidavit stating that on account of Advocate Boycot, his counsel did not turnup today for appearing her brother , hence filed this affidavit requesting to consider as an argument for the above petition and also further stated that her brother/petitioner/Accused is an innocent persons and he is no way connected with the above alleged offences, the petitioner is in judicial custody from 26.02.2026 and he is having a permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused setting fire over the cattle shed and thereby causing fire injury to the

cattle staying inside the cattle and one more previous case is pending against the petitioner, the investigation has been completed.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the offence, period of incarceration, (32 **days**), completion of material portion of investigation, and in the absence of any strong objection, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail Petition is allowed with the following conditions:

1) The Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousands Only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

(2) The Petitioner is directed to report before the learned District Munsif-cum- **Judicial Magistrate Kilpennathur daily(except court holidays)** at 10.00 A.M. for a period of 15 days from the date of his release without fail.

3) The Petitioner shall not tamper any witness, he should co-operate with the investigation, he should not make any undue influence on the witnesses, he should not indulge in any other offence in future and not to leave the station either to abroad or other State without permission of this Court.
