This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.I.Sekar, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. E.Arul Prakash, Learned Advocate appearing for the Respondent/Complainant and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for bail

The petitioner/Accused has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS. prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable u/s. 138 of N.I. Act in **STC.720/2025 of District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Kalasapakkam .**

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner/Accused contended that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case and the NBW issued as against the petitioner on 17.02.2026 and the petitioner is in judicial custody from 17.03.2026, and the petitioner is having permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent submitted that the petitioner/accused did not appear before the trial court, the trial court issued a NBW as against the petitioner and remanded him and also did not comply the conditional order of the trial court hence strongly opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence, period of incarceration, (20 **days**), and the matter is already riped for trial, and in the absence of any serious objection , this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail Petition is allowed with the following conditions:

(1) The Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousands Only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

(2) The Petitioner is directed to report before the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Kalasapakkam daily(except court holidays) at 10.30 A.M. for a period of 30 days from the date of his release without fail.

3) The Petitioner shall not tamper any witness, he should co-operate with the investigation, he should not make any undue influence on the witnesses, he should not indulge in any other offence in future and not to leave the station either to abroad or other State without permission of this Court.
