K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for extension of time.

Heard both sides.

This petition is filed by the petitioner seeking extension of time to furnish sureties before the Jurisdiction Magistrate as per anticipatory bail order passed by this Court in **Cr.M.P.No.466/2026 dated: 05.03.2026**. The petitioner was directed to surrender before the jurisdictional Magistrate within 15 days from 5.03.2026. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner could not surrender before the jurisdictional Magistrate within the time stipulated by this Court due to delay caused in arranging sureties. The reason stated is convincing. Hence, this Court is inclined to allow this petition **extending 10 days further time from today** as a last chance to surrender before the jurisdictional Magistrate and to furnish

sureties and other conditions remain as such in the earlier order and no further extension petition will be entertained. This petition is ordered accordingly.
