This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru.E.Kumaresan, Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State and after hearing either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition for bail

The petitioner/Accused has filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS Act, praying to grant bail to him for the alleged offences punishable under sections, 123 of BNS r/w 24(1) of COTPA Act 2003 (As per Memo) inCr.No.43/2026 of Dusi Police Station.

Heard Both sides. Records perused.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/Accused would contend that the petitioner/accused is an innocent person and he has noway connected with the above alleged offences, the petitioner is in judicial custody from 08.03.2026, the petitioner is having a permanent residence and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner/accused and other co-accused were found in possession of banned tobacco products worth about Rs.1,51,000/-, and the investigation has been completed.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the offence, period of incarceration, (17 **days**), and also the co-accused has already been released on bail by the order of the Hon'ble High Court in CrI.O.P.No.7020/2026 on 18.03.2026, completion of material portion of investigation, and in the absence of any strong objection, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this Bail Petition is allowed with the following conditions:

(1) The Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousands Only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

(2) The Petitioner is directed to report before the **Respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m and 5.30 p.m until further orders and no relaxation petition shall be entertained within a period of 60 days.**

3) The Petitioner shall not tamper any witness, he should co-operate with the investigation, he should not make any undue influence on the witnesses, he should not indulge in any other offence in future and not to leave the station either to abroad or other State without permission of this Court.
