This petition is coming for final hearing before me on 26.08.2025 in the presence of Tr. D. Subramaniyan, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and Tr. D.M. Kathiravan, Additional Public Prosecutor for the Respondent / Complainant and upon hearing the arguments advanced on both sides, upon perusing the petition and records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:-

**ORDER**

This petition is filed under section 483(1)(b) BNSS., 2023 seeking to relax the condition imposed in CrI.M.P. No. 393/2024, dated 19.12.2024.

1. Heard both sides. Records perused.
2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner/Accused stated that the petitioner is charged for the alleged offences punishable u/s. 294(b), 302 IPC. The Petitioner/Accused was granted bail in Cr.M.P.No.393/2024, dated 19.12.2024

with a condition that they should report before this court daily at 10.00 A.M. until further orders. The Petitioner/Accused is abiding the condition before this court every Thursday from 22.12.2024 to till date without fail. The Petitioner/Accused is a coolie and it is very difficult for him to attend the court daily. Therefore the Petitioner/Accused prays to relax the condition.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor objected to relax the conditions and prayed to dismiss the petition.

4. The Petitioner is arrayed as the accused in SC.No.30/2024 in Cr.No. 409/2022 of Polur Police Station for the alleged offences u/s. 294(b), 302 IPC and the case is posted for trial. The Petitioner/Accused was absent for the hearing 27.08.2024 and hence NBW was issued against the Petitioner/Accused. NBW was executed and the accused was arrested on 16.09.2024. Thereafter the accused was granted bail in Cr.M.P.No. 393/2024, on 19.12.2024 with the conditions that he should appear and sign before this court every Thursday at 10.00 a.m, until further orders.

5. From perusal of records it is evident that the Petitioner/Accused has been complying the conditions and he has signed every Thursday from 26.12.2024 to till date. The Petitioner/Accused had stated that he is working as a coolie. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and the major period of compliance the second condition imposed in Cr.M.P.No.393/2024 dated 19.12.2024 is totally relaxed.

All other conditions mentioned in the bail order shall remain the same.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
