This petition is coming before me on this day for hearing Tmt.T.Aananthi appeared for the petitioner side as party in person and Thiru.K.V.Manoharan, learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent, after hearing the petitioner side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed by the petitioner U/s 389(1) of CrI.P.C., praying to suspend the sentence imposed on them by the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tiruvannamalai in C.C.No.122/2016 dated 04.06.2024.

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

The Learned Counsel for the petitioner/appellant submitted that the petitioner have been convicted by the lower court and she was on bail during the time of trial, and the interim suspension of sentence has been ordered by the trial court and further submits that the petitioner have got a good arguable case in the appeal and requests to suspend the sentence imposed on them till the disposal of the main appeal.

The Learned Public Prosecutor leaves the matter to the discretion of the court.

On perusal of the judgment of the trial court, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo as follows:

It is further revealed from the records that the petitioner was on bail throughout the trial period and the sentence were suspended by the trial court U/s 389(3) CrI.P.C. Now, the petitioner/ appellant have preferred a Criminal Appeal and the same is taken on file in **C.A.No.78/2024**.

By considering all these facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant **interim suspension of sentence till 19.07.2024** to the petitioner.

Accordingly, it is hereby ordered to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner till **19.07.2024**, on their executing an own bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-each with two sureties each for a like sum within 15 days from today to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate No I, Tiruvannamalai** and he should appear before this Court at 10.30 A.M. on **19.07.2024** in the main appeal and thereafter on subsequent hearing dates without fail.

This petition is posted to **19.07.2024** for enquiry before this Court with regard to extension of interim suspension bail.
