**ORDER**

1. This is a petition for bail u/s. 483 of BNSS.

2. The petitioner who was arrested formally while NBW was pending against him in SC.No. 121/2024 seeks bail. The petitioner is innocent and his liberty is essential for proper conduct of the case. He has a permanent residence and he will not abscond. He is prepared to furnish sufficient sureties for his appearance.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the Respondent / State, by producing the objections of the Station House Officer, Tiruvannamalai East Police station, strongly opposed granting bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner has been absconding frequently and he has always been causing trouble to the public. Therefore, he is now under custody in Crime No. 225/2025 of

Tiruvannamalai East Police station for offences u/s. 294(b) & 7(1)(a) CLA Act the learned Additional Public Prosecution has also submitted that the petitioner has 4 previous cases.

4. On perusal of the case , it is seen that the petitioner is the only accused in this case for alleged offences u/s. 294(b), 307 r/w 34 , 341, 352, 506(ii) of IPC. The petitioner failed to appear before this court after committal and therefore Non-Bailable Warrant was issued. The petitioner was formally arrested in Execution of Non-Bailable Warrant while he was in custody in Cr.No.225/2025, and was produced before this court and remanded to Judicial Custody. This court also takes note of the fact that the petitioner is A3 in SC.No. 86/2024 for offences u/s. 341, 294(b), 307 r/w 34, 352, 506(ii) of IPC.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the cases, the bad antecedents of the petitioner , the strong objections of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and that there is a likely hood that the petitioner may abscond, this court does not find a prima facie case to grant him bail. The point is answered accordingly.

In the result the petition is dismissed.
