This petition came up before me for final hearing on 24.02.2026 in the presence of Advocate Thiru. G.Aristatil, Advocate for the Petitioners and having heard petitioner side arguments and upon perusal of records and evidences adduces on petitioner side and the case having stood over for the consideration till this day, this court deliver the following:

ORDER

This Petition is filed under section 372 of Indian Succession Act-1925 in order to get the Succession Certificate of deceased sister Venda, with respect to the Rs.80,000/- PF amount along with interest, and hence this Petition.

2. The Petition runs as follows:

The Petitioner states that, Venda is the sister of the Petitioners and she worked at - Employee Provident Fund Organization and died on 02.03.2023 and further submits that, the father of Venda, Duraisamy had died on 25.03.2003, and his mother Kannammal died on 12.01.2024, and further submits that the Venda had died without any doing marriage and therefore submits that the death certificate of venda dated 02.03.2003, and death certificate of kannammal dated 12.01.2024, and legal heir certificate of venda dated 10.06.2023, and legal heir certificate of kannammal dated 15.02.2024 are filed along with Petition, and further submits that, since the venda had died and her parents also

died, and she did not marry during her life time and the Petitioners are the only Second class legal heirs of the Venda and based on the when enquired with Employee Provident Fund Organization, Regional office, Sathuvachari, Vellore, the PF amount of Rs.80,000/- along with interest in the provident fund, and since the Venda is not having any First class legal heirs, hence it is necessary to issue succession certificate in the favour of the petitioners, and hence this Petition.

3.Now the point for consideration is Whether this petition deserves to be allowed or not?

4. Points for consideration:

Heard the petitioner counsel. Records perused. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are the only 2nd class legal heirs of the deceased Venda and in order to prove the case of the petitioners, the Petitioner file proof affidavit and examined as PW1 and marked Ex.P1 to Ex.P8, Ex.P1 is the Death certificate of deceased Venda on 02.03.2023 and Ex.P2 is the Death certificate of father of Venda, Mr.Duraisamy dated 25.03.2003 and Ex.P3 is the Death certificate of mother of Venda, Mrs.Kannammal Dated 12.01.2024 and Ex.P4 is the Legal heir certificate of Venda showing that petitioners are the surviving legal heirs of Venda and Ex.P5 is the Legal heir certificate of Kannammal dated 15.02.2024 and Ex.P6 is the Letter of Account officer of EPS organisation, Vellore and Ex.P7 is the Aadhar cards of Petitioners (4 nos) and Ex.P8 is the copy of Newspaper publication for the objection if any in the petition. Further on the side of petitioner, 2nd petitioner examined as the PW2, and also supported the case of the petitioners.

5.It is seen that the above petition was not objected by anyone and on perusal of the evidences of PW1 and PW2 and Ex.P1 to P8, it is proved that the petitioners are the only surviving legal heir of the Venda who died on 02.03.2023 leaving behind the petitioners, and the mother of petitioner namely Kannammal. The said Kannammal also died subsequently

on 12.01.2024 and since there is no objections for the general publication through Tom-tom and Paper publication, it is seen that it is necessary to allow the present petition as the petitioners are eligible to get the amount in the Employee provident fund organisation, Regional office, Sathurvachari, Vellore with respect to the PF amount of Rs.80,000/- along with interest belonged to deceased Venda. Hence this court is opinion to allow this petition.

In the result, this petition is allowed as follows:

- I. **Declaring that the Petitioners are the 2nd Class legal heirs of the Deceased Venda and are entitled for the Succession Certificate for the amount in the Employee Provident Fund Organisation, Regional office, Sathuvachari, Vellore with respect to the PF amount of Rs.80,000/- along with interest belonged to deceased Venda.**

- II. **There is no order as to the costs.**
