This petition coming before me for final hearing today (28.10.2025) in the presence of Tr. A. Muruganathan, Advocate for the Petitioners /Accused persons and the Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and after hearing both sides and upon perusal of the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

Petition filed U/s, 480 and 483 of BNSS 2023 seeking bail for the Petitioners/Accused. They were charged for the offences U/s, 147, 364, 120(B), 201. 302 rw. 149 of IPC.

1. The Petitioners could not be able to appear before this court, because of their illness and this court had issued Non Bailable Warrant on 20.06.2025 against the Petitioners / Accused persons and the Respondent Police had executed the Non Bailable Warrant and the Accused persons were remanded to Judicial Custody on 04.09.2025. The Petitioners assured that they will appear in future before this court. The Petitioners / Accused persons were falsely implicated in this case. They are innocent of the offences and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the Respondent Police. The Petitioners/Accused persons have not moved for bail before the Honourable High Court of Madras. This is the 3rd Bail Application filed by the Petitioners / Accused persons. The earlier two bail applications were dismissed by this Court in Cri.M.P.No.8/2025, Dated: 15.09.2025 and Cri.M.P.No.9/2025. Dated:26.09.2025. The Petitioners / Accused persons are ready to offer substantial sureties and they would abide by any stringent conditions that may be imposed by this court.

The objections filed by the Respondent Police and Additional Public Prosecutor:

2. Reply received from the concerned Police and Additional Public Prosecutor stating that, they strongly oppose for the release of the Petitioners /Accused persons on bail stating that, Non Bailable Warrant was pending against the Petitioners / Accused persons for a very long period. The Petitioners / Accused persons not appeared before this court for a very long period from 04.09.2025 and for this reason, Non Bailable Warrant was issued against the Petitioners / Accused persons. The Petitioners / Accused persons are absconding, without any valid reasons. If the Petitioners / Accused persons are released on bail, they would hamper the investigation and they would tamper the prosecution witnesses and therefore, the Respondent Police and the Additional Public Prosecutor objected for the release of

the Petitioners / Accused persons.

3. Heard both sides.

4. On perusal of the entire case records, the Petitioners / Accused persons are in Judicial Custody from 04.09.2025. Further, the Petitioners / Accused persons are not involved in other cases and there is no other cases pending against them. The Petitioners / Accused persons have assured that, they would regularly appear before this court and they would abide by any conditions imposed by this court.

5. Considering the nature and circumstances of the case, and also in view of fact the Petitioners / Accused persons are in incarceration for more than 54 days and also that, they are not involved in any other offences and they have assured that, they would regularly appear before this court and they would abide by any conditions imposed by this court, this court is inclined to enlarge the Petitioners / Accused persons on bail on the following terms and conditions..

(a) The Petitioners / Accused persons on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties, and on further condition that:

(b) The sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and to submit a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity:

(c) the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witnesses either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial and Accordingly, this bail application is allowed.

In the result, this Petition is allowed.
