This petition came up before me for hearing on 19.03.2025, Learned Counsel M/s.M.P.Muguntharajan, appeared for petitioner, Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-I appeared for the respondent, upon hearing both side and perusing the entire records, this Court delivers the following:-

ORDER

This petition filed u/s.480 of BNSS. praying to enlarge the accused on bail against the alleged offence u/s.331(4), 62 BNS.

2. The petitioner submitted that false case foisted against the petitioner and petitioner is in judicial custody from 15.02.2025. The petitioner is ready to obey any condition imposed by this Court and petitioner is the only bread winner of the family.

3. The respondent stoutly opposed that if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, he will involve similar offence and may abscond. On behalf of respondent, the respondent Police in the reply stoutly opposed and if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, he will tamper witness and that there are 4 previous cases pending against the

petitioner/accused.

4. The point for determination is whether the petitioner entitled to the bail?

5. Heard both side. Available materials perused. Though the petitioner is in the Judicial Custody for 33 days, considering the facts of this case, nature of the offence, considering that there are 4 previous cases pending against the petitioner/accused. and considering that serious allegations raised against the petitioner and this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Finally, for the above said reasons this petition is dismissed.
