Section 151 CPC for directing the plaintiff, for production of original
documents as mentioned in the plaint and for supplying of its legible
and authenticate copies to the applicants/defendants.**

ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application Order 11 Rule 11, 12, 14 & 15 CPC read with Section 151 CPC for directing the plaintiff, for production of original documents as mentioned in the plaint and for supplying of its legible and authenticate copies to the applicants/defendants.
2. In the application, learned counsel for the applicants/defendants has submitted that the plaintiff has filed the present false and frivolous suit against the applicants/defendants. It is further averred that the plaintiff has relied upon certain documents as mentioned in his plaint, but the plaintiff has not supplied the copies of the same nor its legible copies to the applicants/defendants

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and other relevant documents. It is further averred that without the production and perusal and inspection of the above said documents, the applicants would not be in decipher position to prepare proper and effective written statement/reply to the plaint. Hence, the present application has been filed.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent/plaintiff instead of filing written reply to said application has orally contested the present application on the ground that the said application is not maintainable and same has been filed just to delay the proceedings and prayed for dismissal of the present application. He has further submitted that the applicants can obtain the copy of the same as per law.

4. I have heard the rival submissions of both the parties and perused the file very carefully with their able assistance.

5. Heard. The law regarding the production of document is well settled and clearly laid down in the Order XI Rule 12 and 14 CPC, 1908, wherein, it has been made clear that any party to a proceeding may seek or the Court may order, at any time during the pendency of any suit, production by any party or person, of such documents in the possession or power of such party or person, relating to any matter in question in such suit. The Court can in exercise of its inherent powers direct the parties to the suit to furnish copy of documents essential for the proper adjudication of the case. Thus, in view of the averments mentioned in the application and submissions made by learned counsel for the applicants/defendants and the respondent/plaintiff and law discussed above, the present application is allowed and disposed off *ex debito justitiae*, accordingly

and the respondent/plaintiff is directed to provide the copies of the documents relied upon by him to the applicants/defendants.

6. Nothing above said shall affect the decision of the present suit on merits and observation made above are strictly for deciding the present application in hand.
