**ORDER**

This petition was filed by the petitioner/accused to extend time to produce surety in V.Crl.M.P. No.93/2026 on 15.05.2026.

Heard both sides. By the order dated 15.05.2026, anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in V.Crl.M.P. No.93/2026. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that he was suffering from sudden ill-health during the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May, 2026 and hence he could not surrender and to produce sureties in time and within the stipulated time and seek time for surrender and to produce sureties. Considering above said facts, further one week time is extended to the petitioner for complying the condition.

Hence, time is extended till 11.06.2026.
