This petition coming before me for hearing, on this day, in the presence of Thiru. P. Savarimuthu, Public Prosecutor for the State and of advocate Thiru. S. Parameshwaran, for the petitioner in Crl.M.P. No. 1953/2026 and of advocate Thiru. P. Muruganantham, and after hearing both sides and considering these necessary materials, this court today passed the following:-

ORDER

These 2 applications for bail filed u/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

FIR was registered against the petitioners in both petitions for the offences u/s. 309(4) and 311 of BNS. The occurrence happened on 20.05.2026. The petitioners have been in judicial custody from 21.05.2026 and 22.05.2026 respectively onwards.

According to the learned counsels for the petitioners, the petitioners are innocents and they have not committed any such offence and they have been falsely implicated in this offence and prays to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor contended that it is a case of robbery and the property was recovered and the petitioners are history sheeters and 3 previous cases are pending against the 1<sup>st</sup> accused and out of 15 cases, 11 previous cases are pending against the 2<sup>nd</sup> accused and the investigation is pending and objected to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Heard both sides. Records perused. On perusal of records would show that the petitioner and another accused threatened and put a knife of his neck and robbed a sum of Rs.1000/- from him and the property was recovered by the respondent police. The occurrence happened on 20.05.2026. The petitioners have been in judicial custody from 21.05.2026 and 22.05.2026 respectively. Considering the period of custody of the petitioners and also considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners in both petitions on bail with the following conditions ;

1. The petitioners/accused in both petitions are ordered to be released on bail on executing their own bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- each with two sureties each, **of which one surety must be a blood relative** for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Tiruchirappalli.
2. The petitioners/accused in both petitions shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.
3. The petitioners/accused in both petitions shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police officer as and when required.
4. The petitioners/accused in both petitions shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
5. The petitioners/accused in both petitions shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

6. The Magistrate/Trial court on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners/accused in both petitions in accordance with law as if the conditions has been imposed and the petitioners/accused in both petitions were released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Judge himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala {(2005) AIR SCW 5560}.
7. If the petitioners/accused in both petitions thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered u/s. 269 of BNS, 2023.
