Upon perusing the petition and the relevant materials available on record and upon hearing both sides and having stood over for consideration, this court passed the following: -

ORDER

This bail petition is filed by the Petitioner/Accused praying to relax the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.03/2026, dated 12.05.2026.

The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner was released on bail by this court in CrI.M.P.No. 03/2026, dated 12.05.2026 and with condition to sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M. for until further orders. for until further orders. The petitioner is complying the condition till date without any deviation. Hence, this petition to relax the condition imposed by this court in crmp.No.03/2026, dated 12.05.2026. Per contra, the Learned assistant public prosecutor in her reply submitted that on the instruction of the respondent police, if the condition is relaxed the petitioner/accused would abscond and the same will affect the trial of the case.

3. Heard both the sides, records carefully perused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is complying the condition to sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from 12.05.2026. Further he submitted that, he is complying the condition imposed by this court without fail and is the only bread winner in their family and the daily work of the petitioner has been affected because of complying the condition. Hence, considering the nature and circumstance, this court totally relaxes the condition imposed on bail dated.12.05.2026. The conditions imposed in the above bail order remains intact. In the result the petition is allowed.
