Union Bank of India, a body Corporate constituted under the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act 1970, having its Head office at Mumbai, having many branches all over India and having one of its branches at Keerambur, having its office at Kurichi Street, Keerambur Village and post, Thuraiyur Taluk, Tiruchirappalli District represented by its Branch Manager.

Defendant:

1. R. Senthilkumar, Age 42, son of Renganathan, Door No.9/43, Kalarampatti (oop. To Teashop, 1st Shop), Sengattupatti Village, Thuraiyur Taluk, Tiruchirappalli District.
2. R. Ranjitham, Age 55, Daughter of Velayutham and wife of Periyasamy, Door No.2/85, North Street, Vengadathanur Village, Thuraiyur Taluk, Tiruchirappalli District.

Dispute in Brief:-

The suit for recovery of money.

AWARD

The dispute between the parties having been referred to the Lok-Adalat for determination and the parties having compromised the case for which, the following award is passed.

Both parties along with their counsel present. Matter Negotiated. Settlement arrived. Plaintiff Bank agreed to receive Rs.6,00,000/- as full quit for the suit claim. Defendant paid Rs.1,00,000/- Balance amount Rs.5,00,000/- to be paid within 31.07.2026, failing which the Defendant has to pay 9% interest for the balance amount till its realization. According Award passed. Suit is disposed as settled before National Lok adalat. No cost. Court fee shall be refunded as per rules.

Both parties were entered to the above settlement without coercion and undue influence.
